Color Variant Identification

BL=Bluer **BR**=Browner **D**=Darker **F**=Paler **FN**=Finer **GB**=Coarser
GE=Yellower **GN**=Greener **GR**=Grayer **H**=Lighter **L**=Brighter **R**=Redder
SI= Service Match Formula

“+” = More “-“ = Less

Examples Below: Remember the comparison is to the standard formula.

BL- = Blue **BL.D-** = Blue and Dark **BL.H-** = Blue and Light
BL = Bluer **BL.D** = Blue and Darker **BL.H** = Blue and Lighter
BL+ = Bluest **BL.D+** = Blue and Darkest **BL.H+** = Blue and Lightest

VIN Breakdown

1st Digit of the V.I.N. indicates the Country of Production

1,4,5 = USA	M = Thailand
2 = Canada	S = England
3 = Mexico	T = Hungary
6 = Australia	T = Thailand
8 = Argentina	V = France/Spain
9 = Brazil	W = Germany
J = Japan	X = Russia
K = Korea	Y = Sweden

Check the 11th digit of the VIN to choose the designated formula.

Appl = Application Types:

B = Bumper **C** = Chassis **D** = Door/Window/Frame **E** = Exterior
G = Grill/Radiator **I** = Interior **R** = Roof **S** = Stripe **T** = Two Tone
U = Underhood **W** = Wheel

Determining Country of Production:

Check the 1st digit of the VIN and refer to the VIN Breakdown

Example:

Toyota 1C8

Lunar Mist Silver (**CAN**): 1st digit of VIN should be 2

Lunar Mist Silver (**USA**): 1st digit of VIN should be 1, 4, or 5

Variant Chip Information:

VAR.#### -chipped in the New Variant Ring System

Example: Ford AQ

VAR.1204

NOTE: To look up by reference # or color name, use the Advanced Search tab.

How Much To Mix?

1 Quart = 32oz

¾ Quart (1 ½ Pint) = 24oz

½ Quart (1 Pint) = 16oz

1 Pint (½ Quart) = 16oz

¾ Pint = 12oz

½ Pint = 8oz

¼ Pint = 4oz

Touch-up Bottle (.06 Quart) = 2oz
