Painter Certification / Painter Certification CA Regulations

– Experience “The Art of Refinishing” in an intensive hands-on learning environment. Gain a thorough knowledge of the Standox Refinishing System and productive processes. Learn blending and application techniques with proper spray gun setups. Complete understanding of the plastic repair processes from the preparation of substrates to correct product selection and use of additives to achieve the highest quality in plastic repair. Develop SOPs (Standard Operating Procedures) for the most productive quality repair when back in the Collision Repair Center.

Meet the requirements for EPA Rule 40 CFR Part 63 National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants.

Standex Painter Certification is required for participation in the Standox Lifetime Warranty and PIE Program. Re-certification is required every three (3) years to maintain the Standox Lifetime Warranty and membership in the PIE program. Re-certification may be obtained by completing the Standox Coloristic or Meister Certification courses.

This class is approved by most OEM manufacturers requiring technical training for warranty repairs.

Class size is limited to maximize participation and one-on-one time with the instructor.

Painter Certification CA Regulation includes Waterborne for the regulated markets in California.



Coloristic – Students will attain extended color knowledge through comprehensive training, including detailed classroom instruction relating to color theory. Practice the application of color theory by adjusting predetermined OEM colors to obtain a bendable match. Students will be tested for color visual acuity using color tests developed and used by color professionals. Full understanding and use of Standox Color Tools to achieve a color match.
